

Instructions for Optical Illusion Performer

You are performing the 'Question – Answer' Ambigram Optical Illusion crated by John Langdon

- 1. Download and print off both pages This instruction page is NOT shown on camera
- 2. Practise holding the image page up to your camera so the audience can clearly see it
- 3. Ask the audience what word they see? They will most likely say 'Question'.
- 4. Ask if they can also see the word 'Answer'?
- 5. Explain that this optical illusion is called an ambigram because the letters spelling 'Answer' are in and in between the letters that make up the word 'Question'
- 6. TIP For those have trouble seeing the word 'Answer' tell them the letters are dark blue.
- 7. Conclude by commenting that this optical illusion helps us better understand that sometimes information can be interpreted in more than one way.
